

Built by Russell & Company, Port Glass Scotland, 1908. 8,347 gross tons; 46C long; 58 feet wide. Steam triple expansion engines, twin screw. Servic knots. 2,190 passengers (60 first class second class, 2,000 third class).

Built for Austro-Americana Line, Austri 1908 and renamed **Martha Washingt** New York service. Laid up at New York owing to World War I. Seized by US Government, in 1917 and renamed **US Washington**. Troopship service. Sold Triestino, Italian flag, in 1933 and renamed. Burned and scrapped in 1934.


